



"Call for ideas 2022 - JOBFair" REGULATION

The six Italian schools of excellence (Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna, Scuola Normale Superiore, Gran Sasso Science Institute, IMT Scuola Alti Studi Lucca, SISSA and IUSS Pavia - hereinafter also just "Schools") launch a Call for Ideas for the creation of a "claim" aimed at promoting the job meeting initiative "JOBFair", the next edition of which is scheduled for 12 May 2022. All students of the six Schools can participate in the Call for Ideas following the procedures indicated below in the present regulation.

Object

The object of the "Call for ideas 2022 - JOBFair" is the creation of a "claim", in Italian or English, which can be used to disseminate, identify and promote the JOBFair initiative (hereinafter "Claim"). The "Claim" must be unpublished and original. Should the commission find that the text is not original, it will exclude the proposed "Claim" from the selection.

Time period

The "Call for ideas 2022 - Job Fair" is open **until May 4, 2022**.

Participation

Participation in the "Call for ideas 2022 - JOBFair" is free, open to all students regularly enrolled in one of the 6 Schools and subject to the acceptance of the present conditions of participation.

To participate in the Call for Ideas, students must send their "Claim" proposal via email to jobfair@santannapisa.it **within May 4, 2022**, accompanied by a declaration of authorship and originality of the work and acceptance of the conditions of participation including the transfer of the rights to use the "Claim" in favor of the six Schools (*see declaration attached*).

Ranking and award ceremony

The "Claims" will be evaluated by a Commission composed of a member from each one of the six Schools, based on a judgment of originality and relevance to the initiative. The Commission's judgment is final and unappealable.

A € 350 Feltrinelli gift card will be awarded to the author of the "Claim" first classified in the final ranking.

The first "Claim" of the ranking will be published on a full page of Il Sole 24 Ore a few days before the JOBFair Spring Edition 2022 event and will be used to promote the initiative and eventually, at the discretion of the six Schools, for the subsequent editions of the JOBFair. The Commission reserves the right to declare the Call for Ideas unsuccessfully if no proposal meets the requirements of originality and relevance to the initiative.

Rights and responsibilities of the participants. Transfer of rights.

The claim proposal must be owned by the author and unpublished. Each participant must declare that he / she possesses all the rights on the "Claim" and is responsible for the material transmitted, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the six Schools of any liability related to the infringement of the rights of third parties. The winner, without prejudice to the right to authorship of the work, by participating in the Call for Ideas and by virtue of the award recognized, assign to the six Schools the right to the exclusive use of the "Claim" in association with the JOBFair initiative, also to promotional and advertising purposes, with express authorization for the publication and dissemination of the claim on any medium (paper and / or digital), by the Schools or by third parties, with the sole obligation for the Schools to indicate in the publication, where compatible with the medium used, the author's name. The winner also assign to the six Schools the right to modify the "Claim", to reproduce it even partially and in association with other writings, images, logos, to translate it and to distribute it.

Information on the processing of personal data

The personal data communicated in the context of "Call for ideas 2022 - JOBFair" will be processed exclusively for the purposes related to the management of the competition of ideas by authorized subjects and trained for this purpose in compliance with current legislation. At the end of the competition, the personal data communicated will be destroyed. The data holders have the right to ask the Data Controller, i.e. the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna, at any time, at the contacts indicated below, to exercise the rights referred to in Articles 15 and ss. of the GDPR and, in particular, access to personal data, rectification, integration, as well as if the regulatory requirements are met, their cancellation, limitation of data processing and the right to object to their processing. Without prejudice to the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data pursuant to art. 77 of the GDPR.
